Young artists get involved through their local PTA or PTSA. Only original works of art are accepted. A student may submit an entry in any of these six arts areas:

- Visual Arts
- Photography
- Literature
- Music Composition
- Dance Choreography
- Film Production

Deadline for turning in entries to the school will be _____ for judging. Shoreline PTA Council will accept 20 total advancing entries per school to move on to the district level competition.
