


Northshore Council PTSA "Outstanding" Awards

Outstanding Service Award

This is the highest honor bestowed by WSPTA and is presented to a PTA leader/volunteer who may already have been honored, but who has continued to play an active role by giving extraordinary volunteer service to children. This person works for ALL children beyond the bounds of a job description, PTA unit or specific school community. Who would you recommend and why? All of us know someone whom we feel has stepped above and beyond in our community. Please consider nominating that person today.

Outstanding Advocate Award

Do you know someone who is an impassioned and compassionate leader, dedicated to advocating for the health, welfare, safety and education of ALL children, and committed to ensuring that others do the same? Then they are the perfect nominee for this award. This person could be a **legislative grassroots advocate**, a **district administrator** or **staff member**, or a **community member** who goes beyond their normal job description by making a significant advocacy contribution to the students of Northshore.

Outstanding Educator Award

Think of an individual - a teacher, assistant, custodian, bus driver, administrator or community member - who has gone beyond the normal expectations of their job to make the learning environment fun, beneficial, and challenging. Someone who directly influences the success of a student. This person is a worthy candidate for this award so please consider nominating them.

Honorary Lifetime Membership Award

This special award is given to an individual who has not only volunteered their time and made a significant contribution to PTA, but who also has a strong belief in PTA, works with the organization, and supports its growth and development. This description most likely fits a number of people you know so please tell us about them through your nomination.

Nominations Should Include:

- Name of nominee
- PTA service, qualifications, and an explanation as to why you think they should be honored
